PAPER PRESENTATIONS

Abstract Submission

Authors will be required to submit an abstract not more than 300 words including the title and body of the abstract. The abstract should not contain any illustrations, graphs or image. Abstracts must be previously unpublished work at the time of submission.

The accepted abstracts will be informed to submit conference paper meeting the guidelines. Timing for paper presentation will be 30 minutes including discussion.

POSTERS PRESENTATIONS

A section of the venue will be dedicated to poster stands where the presenters will display their presentations. The topics will be the same as for paper presentations.

Display Configurations

The Standard Poster Display is a 1.2 x 2 m (approx.) double-sided panel. These panels have a horizontal orientation. The top edge of the panel is approximately 2m above the floor. The bottom edge is usually 60cm above the floor.



Mounting of Display Materials

Poster may be mounted with tape or double sided sticker.



Poster Printing

Posters can be assembled from pieces of computer printed sheets, or hand-drawn in a manner the presenter considers best. Facilities exist in Kuwait and elsewhere for large format printing which may be utilized at presenter's own expense.



Guidelines for the presenters

Please plan your presentation with the following points in mind:

- » Use concrete examples;
- » Include hints for immediate user implementation;
- » Don't be theoretical – use true stories or case studies;
- » Use best practices, including a variety of opinions.

Paper & Poster presenters are expected to:

- » Work closely with Conference planners in advance of the Conference;
- » Provide a high-quality Conference paper for inclusion in proceedings CD; a detailed format guideline will be sent to the authors of the approved abstracts;
- » Provide a short outline of the presentation for inclusion in the Conference brochure;
- » Make no substantive changes in content, process, names or numbers of presenters without the approval of the conference planners;
- » Agree to have the session audio and video recorded to provide ongoing learning for Conference participants unable to attend their session (if appropriate to proposed design);
- » Agree to refrain from marketing their products or services and to share openly their knowledge, experience, skills, and creativity with participants.
- » Agree to high quality Audio Video presentation
